Next Week Math

For Saxon Math this week we will learn about writing numbers in expanded form, multiplying a three digit number by a one digit number, and making change from \$1. We will have a review on Thursday and a test on Friday.

Please be sure to practice math facts at home if your child is struggling.

For AZ Merit math this week we will be reviewing what we have learned about fractions so far.

Reading

We will start the book "Holidays Around the World." This week we will read the introduction and learn about Ramadan, Hanukah, Christmas, and Kwanza.

The AZ Merit classwork will be "Donkey and Friends" and the AZ Merit homework will be "Fishling and Friends". We will be focusing on writing about what we read.

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Language
