Next Week Math

This week for Saxon Math we will be learning how to write equal groups story problems, how to write three-digit numbers using words, how to write a check, how to estimate sums. We will review how to round numbers. There will be math homework every night.

This week for AZ Merit Math we will review addition properties, add two and three digit numbers to 1,000, and subtract two and three digit numbers within 1,000.
