Long Term Projects to Monitor

1. Book Log (Follow all of the directions for success)
2. Book Report (Follow ALL of the directions. Parents should be assisting with and check the book reports)

There is homework Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday nights. Although there is not homework over the weekend, students should be working on any long term projects.

Math

There are two piece of math homework every night.

There is a math comprehension sheet and a math facts sheet.

The math comprehension sheet covers five/six different topics that we have covered so far throughout the school year.

There is a “guided class practice” side of this math homework.

On that side we work through every problem step by step in class and students are expected to follow along and write the answers as well as take notes. This side of the paper will help them with the homework side. If they have questions on the math homework they should flip to the other side and see how we solved the problem. I pass back math homework the next day with corrections.

The math fact sheet is the other piece of math homework.

All 100 math facts should be answered.

An adult should time how long it take the student to complete the math facts and sign stating that they checked the math facts.

Spelling

On Monday and Tuesday students put the spelling words into ABC Order.

On Wednesday we take a spelling practice test in class. On Wednesday night for homework students write any words that they got wrong on the spelling pretest 5 times each.

On Thursday students have a “Spelling Skills” worksheet. This sheet goes over various spelling concepts with the weeks selling words.

Reading

There is reading homework every week as well. The homework goes home on Tuesday night and should be returned on Friday. The reading homework is directly correlated to the AZ Merit Test, which is the Arizona State Standardized Test.

Other

During the week there may also be language, writing, science or social studies homework. These assignments change every week.

We write homework assignments in our agenda nightly to keep ourselves accountable.

Students always have two additional assignments each night.

First, they should be reading for 15 minutes.

Second, they should have parents sign their agenda.
